Chairman Loomis opened the regular meeting at 9:00 a.m. Commissioner Becker made a motion to approve the agenda for March 23, 2015. Commissioner Linaweaver seconded. **All voted aye.**

During Public Input at 9:00 a.m., Laurie Wizarde, Register of Deeds, informed Commissioners that she has been asked to help organize and educate newly elected Deeds officials at the 2017 Kansas Register of Deeds Association Education Conference.

At 9:10 a.m. Darren Frazier, Director of Emergency Management/Communications, joined the meeting to discuss the possibility of replacing the current 911 dispatching system with an updated, unified, statewide "Next Generation" call handling 911 program, through AT&T. The first step in proceeding with the proposed update would be to request an onsite analysis survey by AT&T. Mr. Frazier noted that many Kansas counties are currently on a waiting list for the site analysis. Following discussion, Commissioner Becker made a motion for Mr. Frazier to request placement of McPherson County 911 on the end of the waiting list. Commissioner Linaweaver seconded. **All voted aye.**

At 9:41 a.m., David Page joined the meeting to request a change in grade on the McPherson County step and grade chart, for the Victim Witness Coordinator position. Following discussion, all Commissioners agreed to table the request until more information is gathered regarding salary survey comparisons.

At 10:10 a.m. Dianna Carter, County Appraiser, joined the meeting to request approval of a Personnel Change Notice (PCN) for Terri Voth to change from an Appraiser I to a Personal Property Appraiser (8B), effective April 12, 2015, to fill a vacancy. Commissioner Linaweaver made a motion for the Chairman to sign the PCN as presented. Commissioner Becker seconded. **All voted aye.**

At 10:13, Tom Kramer, Public Works Director, joined the meeting with three (3) items:

- A. A request to approve a PCN to hire Chris Milleson as a Maintenance Worker I (9D), effective March 24, 2015, to fill a vacancy. Commissioner Becker made a motion for the Chairman to sign the PCN as presented. Commissioner Linaweaver seconded. **All voted aye.**
- B. A request to hire Ron Jones as a Part-time Temporary Seasonal Maintenance Worker I (9A), effective March 15, 2015, to fill a vacancy. Commissioner Linaweaver made a motion for the Chairman to sign the PCN as requested. Commissioner Becker seconded. **All voted aye.**
- C. A request to approve the purchase of replacement tires. Following a discussion of bids, Commissioner Linaweaver made a motion to approve the purchase from Canton Service Center in an amount not to exceed \$5,845.52. Commissioner Becker seconded. **All voted aye.**

At 10:23 a.m., Janet Cagle, Director of Harvey/McPherson Counties Community Corrections, joined the meeting to present budget information and current funding data.
