Chairman Linaweaver opened the regular meeting at 9:00 a.m. One item was added to the agenda for April 4, 2016: Old Mill Museum Work Session. Commissioner Becker made a motion to approve the agenda as amended. Commissioner Loomis seconded. **All voted aye.**

No one spoke during Public Input at 9:00 a.m.

Commissioner Loomis made a motion to approve the minutes for March 28, 2016. Commissioner Becker seconded. **All voted aye.**

Commissioner Becker made a motion to approve adds and abates for April 1, 2016. Commissioner Loomis seconded. **All voted aye.**

Commissioner Loomis made a motion for the Chairman to sign a Personnel Change Notice to end the introductory status of Angela Butler, CDDO Clerk (6B), effective April 10, 2016. Commissioner Becker seconded. **All voted aye.**

At 9:10 a.m., Sandra Bradley, CASA, and representatives from Heart to Heart joined the meeting to request the Chairman's signature on a Proclamation designating the month of April 2016 as Child Abuse Prevention Month. Commissioner Loomis made a motion for the Chairman to sign the proclamation as presented. Commissioner Becker seconded. **All voted aye.**

At 9:20 a.m., John Verssue, Planning/Zoning & Environment Administrator joined the meeting with three (3) items:

- A. A request from Marion County for mortgage inspection assistance. Following discussion it was a consensus among Commissioners that McPherson County will deny the request and recommended that Marion County defer the request to another county.
- B. A request to approve the notification of property owners at 14<sup>th</sup> Ave. and Pioneer road regarding a vacation of the right -of-way. Commissioner Becker made a motion to approve the request as presented. Commissioner Loomis seconded. **All voted aye.**
- C. A request to approve a Wastewater System Waiver at 347 18<sup>th</sup> Ave., Moundridge, KS. Commissioner Loomis made a motion to approve the request as presented. Commissioner Becker seconded. **All voted aye.**

At 9:33 a.m., Fern Hess, Health Department Director, joined the meeting to request approval to purchase 4 tablet computers and accessories for use by the Registered Nurses at the Health Department in order to enter individual, client-specific demographic and immunization information regarding immunization administration, and future data entry requirements being proposed for

implementation by the KDHE Maternal Child Health and Family Planning Programs. Following discussion, Commissioner Becker made a motion to approve the purchases in an amount not to exceed \$7,000.00. Commissioner Loomis seconded. **All voted aye.**

At 11:00 a.m., Commissioner recessed and reconvened at 9:00 a.m. on April 8, 2016 in the County Clerk's office to canvass votes from the recent USD #423 special question mail ballot election on a general obligation bond. At 9:30 a.m., Chairman Linaweaver adjourned the meeting.
