

## BOARD OF MCPHERSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

March 2, 2010  
10:00 a.m. Regular Meeting  
All Present

Three (3) items were added to the agenda for March 2, 2010: Judicial Appointment; Non-elected Personnel in the Sheriff's Department; and Board appointments for Lone Tree Township. Commissioner Loomis made a motion to approve the agenda as amended. Commissioner Terry seconded. **All voted aye.**

During Public Input at 10:00 a.m., Dianna Carter, County Appraiser, joined the meeting to report the 2009 Valuation Data and Ratio Study results. McPherson County met compliance with 99.8% accuracy in residential property and 97.4% in commercial/industrial property.

At 10:15 a.m., Janet Cagle, Community Corrections Director, joined the meeting to request approval of a Personnel Change Notice (PCN) to promote Angela LaGree to a Secretary II/Administrative Assistant (8B) effective March 14, 2010. Commissioner Terry made a motion to approve the PCN as presented. Commissioner Loomis seconded. **All voted aye.**

Commissioner Terry made a motion to approve the minutes for February 23, 2010 as corrected. Commissioner Loomis seconded. **All voted aye.**

Commissioner Loomis made a motion to approve adds and abates for February 26, 2010. Commissioner Terry seconded. **All voted aye.**

Rick Witte, County Administrator, presented on behalf of the Sheriff's Department a PCN to hire Cecilia Cunnick as a Female Correctional Officer (12A), effective March 15, 2010, to fill a vacancy. Commissioner Terry made a motion to approve the PCN as presented. Commissioner Loomis seconded. **All voted aye.**

Mr. Witte presented a request for the selection of a non-attorney member to serve on the 9<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Nominating Committee. Commissioner Loomis made a motion to reappoint Ellis Musselwhite for the position. Commissioner Terry seconded. **All voted aye.**

Mr. Witte presented two (2) requests from The Lone Tree Township Board:

1. Approval of the resignation of Jason Krehbiel as Trustee and recommendation of Charles Redger as his replacement to finish out his term.
2. Approval of the request by Jeremy Hall to be relieved of his duties as Clerk, and be replaced by Roan Unruh to finish out his term.

Commissioner Loomis made a motion to approve the requests as presented. Commissioner Terry seconded. **All voted aye.**

At 10:30 a.m. Lorna Nelson, Director of the Old Mill Museum, joined the meeting with two (2) items:

- A. A request to approve a PCN for additional hours for Sheila Malm, Temporary Data Entry Clerk of the Bygdeband North American pilot project. The position is funded fully through Genline.SE. Commissioner Terry made a motion to approve the PCN as presented. Commissioner Loomis seconded. **All voted aye.**
- B. A request to approve the low bid by Unruh Basement Construction for the ADA accessible concrete ramp projects on the First County Courthouse building and the Erickson Brothers Farm Workshop building. The total combined bid for both buildings amounts to \$3,900.00. Commissioner Loomis made a motion to approve the request as presented for an amount not to exceed \$3,900.00. Commissioner Terry seconded. **All voted aye.**

At 11:30 a.m., Chairman Patrick adjourned the meeting.
