
REOPENING MCPHERSON COUNTY BY ORDER OF THE MCPHERSON COUNTY LOCAL HEALTH OFFICER

Effective May 4th, 2020, at 12:01 am, McPherson County will implement the restrictions set forth by the Governor of Kansas in Executive Order No. 20-29, implementing Phase One of “Ad Astra: A Plan to Reopen KANSAS.”

Section 1. Furthermore, the McPherson County Local Health Officer will implement the following restrictions to be read in conjunction with Executive Order No. 20-29:

1. Per the U.S. Food & Drug Administration recommendation, self-serve food or beverages are prohibited. This includes but is not limited to salad bars, buffets, and beverage service stations that require customers to use common utensils or dispensers.
2. Garage sales, yard sales and similar activities are prohibited due to the difficulty to contact trace when individuals do not know each other.
3. Public park equipment and seating is to remain closed due to the longevity of coronavirus living on surfaces that cannot be cleaned before each use.

Section 2. The McPherson County Local Health Officer and the McPherson County Health Department have put together guidance documents that should be referred to when implementing Phase One of “Ad Astra: A Plan to Reopen KANSAS,” and the local restrictions set forth in this document. These can be found on the McPherson County website at mcpersoncountyks.us.

Section 3. This Order may be supplemented or modified as required for the effective and efficient management and control of the COVID-19 pandemic in McPherson County by further order or direction of the Board of County Commissioners, acting as the Board of Health, or by the McPherson County Local Health Officer.

Section 4. This Order is effective immediately on May 4th, 2020, at 12:01 am, and shall remain in effect for the longevity of Executive Order 20-29, unless sooner amended, superseded, or rescinded.
