

Advance Ballots

ALL AREAS OF THE ADVANCE APPLICATION FORM MUST BE FILLED OUT IN ORDER TO BE ACCEPTED

Single Advance Ballot Application (AV1) is good for one election **ONLY**, the election date **MUST** be filled in at the bottom left hand corner.

Permanent Advance Ballot Application (AV2) is good indefinitely for voters that are not able to get out. The permanent disability or illness **MUST** be filled out.

You may return your ballot **IN PERSON** or by Mail

- If returning **IN PERSON**, this ballot **MUST** be returned by 7PM on Election Day to either:
 - County Clerk's Office
 - ANY polling location within the County
- If returning by **MAIL**, Letter rate postage is required. The ballot envelope must be postmarked by 7PM on Election Day and received no later than the Friday after Election.

Be sure to follow **ALL** of the instructions on the return envelope:

1. You **MUST** sign the back of the envelope, if not your ballot will not be counted
2. If someone is delivering the envelope for you, they **MUST** sign also. A person may **NOT** deliver more than 10 ballots on behalf of other persons during the election in which the ballot is being cast.

Please remember to bring your government issued photo I.D. to vote in person
A complete list of acceptable ID's is on our website. Free IDs are available if you do not have one; contact our office.
